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Dear Keeseville Families,

Welcome back to our hybrid model. We look forward to continuing to partner with you to provide our students with a rigorous, engaging and high quality elementary school experience. I know this year has been difficult but we will continue to work together to make sure your child's social, emotional and academic needs are met.

Here are some reminders as we get ready to start in person instruction again.

- The first day of in person for **Team A** students will be Tuesday, **February 2nd**
The first day of in person for **Team B** students will be Wednesday, **February 3rd**
- Our start and dismissal times will still be modified. School drop off will officially start at 7:45 am. No students will enter the building before 7:45am. **Please do not drop your child off at school before 7:45 am** because there will be no supervision. Also, no parents will be entering the building.
- Dismissal will start at 1:45 pm. Parents will not be allowed to enter the building. We will be following the same procedures that we put in place at the beginning of the year. Please contact the office if you need your numbers reissued for pick up.
- Please keep the school informed of any change in address, phone number or email address. During the course of the year we may need to contact you by regular mail, email or phone. All robo-calls will go out to the phone numbers given at the beginning of the year. Please be sure to clean out voicemail boxes so we can leave a message. In addition, we are making an effort to use text messages to get information to our families.
- **Bus notes still will not be accepted due to limited seating on the bus.** We understand emergencies may arise. Please contact the building principal if there is an emergency situation that would affect transportation.
- Teachers who instruct our fully remote sections will be contacting our families and students who chose the fully remote option to share their weekly schedule.
